- Copy of your high school diploma and last year transcripts;
- Copy of any postsecondary diploma/degree and last year transcripts;
- a copy of your birth certificate;
- ID page of passport;
- Admission fees (50\$) & Enrollment fees (200\$), total amount of \$250.00 (non-refundable);

It is very important that you return your completed original application to the Bureau of International Students **by mail** as soon as possible. We will then submit the application on your behalf.
